

## SUMMER HUNT VI EQUESTRIAN PRE-REGISTRATION 2010

Equestrian Cards can be issued at Rider Sessions #1 and #2 (see schedule below) for those who need to Authorize or Re-authorize (if your card is getting ready to expire).

### EQUESTRIAN MARSHALS

You will need your authorization card in order to marshal.

### RIDERS

You will need your authorization card in order to compete.

### GROUNDCREW

You will need your authorization card in order to do groundcrew.

### PET POLICY

THL Agelos and the Autocrat are responsible for keeping resident livestock safe and SCA pet regulations enforced:

#### **Dogs-**

Unleashed dogs are prohibited. Dog owners must have proof of Rabies vaccination with them, because we will ask them to provide it when they arrive on site. A Rabies tag is NOT legal proof. Dogs are NOT allowed in the horse area at all. We will ask any person to remove their pet if it causes any problems anywhere on site. Pets cannot be left unattended. Due to the hot weather, owners are cautioned to keep pets well-hydrated.. All pet stools must be immediately picked up and disposed of in proper stool receptacles. Pets are not allowed to defecate/urinate within camping areas.

#### **Horses-**

Horses must be vaccinated against EWEE, Tetanus, Flu, Rhino, and WNV and current on deworming. Worms are very contagious and it is imperative that you deworm your horses before sharing space with other horses or exposing resident livestock to your horses. Horses must be kept in the horse designated areas only (this will be demarcated on the Site Map) . Horse manure must be picked up and disposed in the assigned receptacle/area. For Interstate Travelers (those not originating in Washington), please remember that you MUST bring a copy of a current Coggins certificate. This must be shown to the equestrian marshal/representative before you unload your horses.

**Mounted Hunter**--the famous 3D hunt course will be set up again. Bring your bows, spears, and javelins--hunters can choose what to use to kill the 'game.'

\*Paddock and horsetrailer space on site is at a premium . Contact [Donwenna](#) to reserve space immediately. Only room for minimum number of horses on site. Stalls available off-site for \$25 per night.

\*The Betting Man's Guide will be included in the Site Handout. This is a list that names the Mounted Hunters that will be used to help folks when they are bidding on their Hunter/horse during the Rider Auction. Each Hunter has a short story that tells something about him/her and will include some sort of amusing comment about each Rider and their horse. This would help the spectators "know" the horses and riders, so the spectators can bid on a 'rider to buy' to run the Hunt Course. If their Rider wins, then both 'owner' and Rider will get a Prize(s).

We have a fenced grassy area for an 'arena' & 'paddocks' , and water access brought to these areas. Primitive camping, at this site; you will need to bring your own paddocks/ fencing. Horses are only allowed in the Horse designated areas according to the Site Map which will be posted on site AND according to the express directives of the EMIC. In other words, if an EMIC tells you to move a horse, then move it to the designated area. No horses are permitted in the populace encampments whatsoever. An additional Equestrian Site Handout may be provided prior to the event. Verbal directives may also be expressed by the EMIC during the event. Please be aware, as per Society and An Tir Equestrian regulations that it is mandatory to obey the directives of the EMIC regardless of whether they are written or verbal.
